15 or a default judgment may be entered against you without notice. A default judgment is one where
16 Plaintiffs are entitled to what they ask for because you have not responded. If you serve a Notice
17 of Appearance on the undersigned person, you are entitled to notice before a default judgment may
18 be entered.

19 You may demand that the Plaintiffs file this lawsuit with the Court. If you do so, the
20 demand must be in writing and must be served upon the person signing this Summons. Within
21 fourteen (14) days after you serve the demand, Plaintiffs must file this lawsuit with the Court, or
22 the service on you of this Summons and Complaint will be void.


23 If you wish to seek the advice of an attorney in this matter, you should do so promptly so
